

The probate of the last will & testament of Sir George Duckett late of Upper Grosvenor Street in the County of Middlesex Bart, deceased, bearing date the 20<sup>th</sup> day of October 1820, whereby, after giving certain pecuniary legacies as therein expressed, he gave & bequeathed unto his son George Duckett Esqr, now Sir George Duckett, Bart all his manors, messuages, lands, tenements & hereditaments & all other his estate & affects whatsoever, both real & personal. To hold to him his heirs, administrators and assigns, according to the nature tenure of the same estate, and appointed his said Son sole executor of his said will; which said will is witnessed by George Bramwell, Thomas

Farmer, & George Dean McLeod, all of 3 Piper Buildings Inn Temple London Gentlemen: And is hereby required to be Registered by the said Sir George Duckett, the sole Executor and Devisee in the said instrument Will, mentioned. As Witness his hand & seal this 24<sup>th</sup> day of July 1823.
